Let us know about ICPS in more details, ICPS indicates a shift of focus from Scheme Approach to Project Approach. It emphasizes Family-based Non- Institutional Care. Knowing about ICPS will help you to describe that the objectives of the ICPS are to Institutionalize essential services and strengthen structures for emergency outreach, institutional care, family and community based care, counselling and support services at the national, regional, state and district levels;

- Enhance capacities at all levels, of all functionaries including, administrators and service providers, members of allied systems including, local bodies, police, judiciary
- Create database and knowledge base for child protection services, including MIS and child tracking system in the country for effective implementation and monitoring of child protection services
- Strengthen child protection at family and community level
- Ensure appropriate inter-sectoral response at all levels
- Raise public awareness, educate public on child rights and protection

The components of the ICPS are:

- Institutional Care
- Non-Institutional Care
- MIS: Child Tracking System & Missing Children Website
- Emergency Outreach Services
