Schemes for Children

The JJ Act, 2015 covers a wide range of issues relating to children and it intersects with other laws.

It is therefore imperative to also recognise that there are several schemes and programmes that will have to be drawn, to ensure that the rights of all categories of children at different levels - panchayat, block and district are not violated and also for the successful implementation of the JJ Act.

The most important scheme is the Child Protection Services [erstwhile Integrated Child Protection Scheme (ICPS)], which was initiated as part of the 11th Five Year Plan and which is the main scheme through which the institutions/system mechanisms for implementation of the JJ Act 2015 as well as of the child protection initiatives are set up such as – DCPU, Child Line, CWC, JJB etc.

Other schemes for rights of children
